- 2 hurdles with name/logo front and back \$1,000
- 5 hurdles with name/logo front and back \$2,500
- 8 hurdles with name/logo front and back \$4,000 (1 row across track)
- 10 hurdles with name/logo front and back \$5,000 (1 lane around track)
- 20 hurdles with name/logo front and back \$10,000
- 35 hurdles with name/logo front and back \$17,500
- 70 hurdles with name/logo front and back \$35,000
